Patient Driven Payment Model – Prepare for Success

The Patient Driven Payment Model (PDPM) will overhaul SNF Medicare reimbursement starting October 1, 2019 and represents the largest change to Medicare reimbursement in 20 years. PDPM will replace the current Resource Utilization Groups (RUGs)-based system. This transition will impact each employee at your organization, so it is critical that SNFs develop a PDPM preparation plan to ease the transition burden and facilitate future financial health.
