## Managing Emerging Infectious Diseases in the LTC Environment

When the media reports a potential new and emerging pandemic panic can ensue. It is frightening and the unknown variables play into that fear. On March 4<sup>th</sup> CMS called for all health care providers to activate infection control practices and issued new guidance to inspectors as they inspect facilities affected by Coronavirus.
