MO HealthNet Proposed Changes to the Medicaid Reimbursement Methodology for NHs

Two big changes to the methodology include applying an acuity adjustment or Case-Mix Index (CMI) to patient care cost and providing quality-based incentives or Value Based Purchasing (VBP) add-ons to the rate when the facility meets specified quality measures criteria. This session will cover how MDS assessments will be used for Missouri Medicaid reimbursement and which MDS items go into the RUG-IV 48 Group model. Participants will have a better understanding of the Value Based Purchasing aspect of Medicaid Case-Mix. We will review what impacts each Quality Measure and examples of what quality improvement practices can be implemented for each of the QMs. Participants will be able to use that information to audit and ensure proper processes are in place to meet the needs of the residents.

Navigating the Nursing Home Five-Star Quality Rating System

This session will review the different data sources available for quality monitoring. Attendees will receive an overview of the Care Compare Nursing Home Five-Star Quality Rating System and each domain that makes up the rating. In addition, a review of both internal and external data sources available to monitor an organization's quality improvement.

Phase III – Coming to Life

It's finally here – the RoP guidance we've all been waiting for! This session will provide an overview of new and updated regulatory requirements, surveyor guidance, and highlight Quality of care related F-Tags. Participants will learn about new expectations regarding infection control and the infection preventionist role, including information about enhanced barrier precautions and MDROs; arbitration agreements; and assessing and educating for trauma-informed care, including post-COVID PTSD. The session will also clarify some life safety issues and food and nutrition. Be sure to join us as we wander into the newest regs and how best to navigate the expectations.
